MANCHESTER ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Manchester Road, Preston from its junction with Church Street to outside of number 7 Manchester Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Avenham Lane – Queen Street – Stanley Street – Ring Way – Percy Street – Lords Walk – Church Row.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer repair works to be carried out.
