MANCHESTER ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Manchester Road, Preston from its junction with Church Street to outside of number 7 Manchester Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Avenham Lane – Queen Street – Stanley Street – Ring Way – Percy Street – Lords Walk – Church Row.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer repair works to be carried out.
