

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CARTMELL LANE, NATEBY, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Cartmell Lane, Nateby from its junction with Kilcrash Lane in a northerly direction to outside the Bowling Green.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1430 hours on Monday 3rd March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Black Lane <> Island Lane <> Church Lane <> Broad Lane <>
Park Lane <> Nateby Crossing Lane <> Longmoor Lane <>
Kilcrash Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
