(CARTMELL LANE, NATEBY, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Cartmell Lane, Nateby from its junction with Kilcrash Lane in a northerly direction to outside the Bowling Green.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1430 hours on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Black Lane <> Island Lane <> Church Lane <> Broad Lane <> Park Lane <> Nateby Crossing Lane <> Longmoor Lane <> Kilcrash Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
