(U294 MARTIN LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U294 Martin Lane, Burscough from the access to the property named Langley Farm to a point 20m South West of the level crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 18th January 2025 until 0700 hours on Sunday 19th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U294 Martin Lane, Burscough is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing replacement works to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
