(U472 BACK LANE, NEWBURGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of U472 Back Lane, Newburgh from the northern boundary of the property named The Cottage to a point 45m East of the eastern boundary of the property named Danesend.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Tuesday 21st January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access, including emergency services, will not be maintained due to the width of the road and nature of the works making it not possible for this to be maintained.
- 4. An alternative route for all traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U472 Back Lane, Newburgh – A5209 Course Lane, Newburgh – U3660 Sandy Lane, Newburgh and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection installation works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
