(C120 MILL LANE, AUGHTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C120 Mill Lane, Aughton from B5195 Formby Lane, Aughton to the southeastern boundary of the property Birches Brow Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 21st January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5195 Formby Lane, Aughton – C121 Turnpike Road, Aughton – A59 Northway, Aughton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd on behalf of BT.
