(SPODDEN FOLD, WHITWORTH, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Spodden Fold, Whitworth from approximately its junction with Hall Street, Whitworth to approximately the southwestern boundary of property number 2.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on 5th January 2025 until 2359 hours on 11th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that Spodden Fold, Whitworth is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the completion of urgent repair works to consequential damage caused by water main leak to be carried out by Lancashire County Council and United Utilities.
