GOOSNARGH LANE, GOOSNARGH, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh from its junction with Haymaker Way to its junction with Oakleaf Close.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 10th February 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 2nd March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Goosnargh Lane – Church Lane – Whittingham Lane – Langley Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow drainage installation works to be carried out.
