LEMONIUS STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN /BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lemonius Street, Accrington from its junction of Liverpool Road for a distance of 61 metres in an easterly direction
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours on Tuesday 21st January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via- Royds Street – Hudsin Street – Augusta Street – Clement Street – South Street – Bishop Street – Rough Lee Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to telecom pole maintenance works undertaken by Dutton Traffic Management Services
