(U960 NARROW LANE, CLIEVES HILL, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U960 Narrow Lane, Clieves Hill from U957 Booths Lane, Aughton to a point 30m North of the northern boundary of the property named The Beaches.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 27th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U957 Booths Lane, Aughton – C116 Gaw Hill Lane, Aughton – A59 Liverpool Road, Main Carriageway – A59 Holborn Hill, Ormskirk – C107 Cottage Lane, Ormskirk – C107 Asmall Lane, Ormskirk – C107 Asmall Lane, Scarisbrick – U1027 Cut Lane, Aughton – U960 Narrow Lane, Clieves Hill and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd on behalf of BT.
