(WOOD LANE, PARBOLD, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wood Lane, Parbold from the southeastern boundary of the property named Tanglewood to the southwestern boundary of property number 2.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 27th January 2025 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 4th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that Wood Lane, Parbold is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation works for new electrical connection to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
