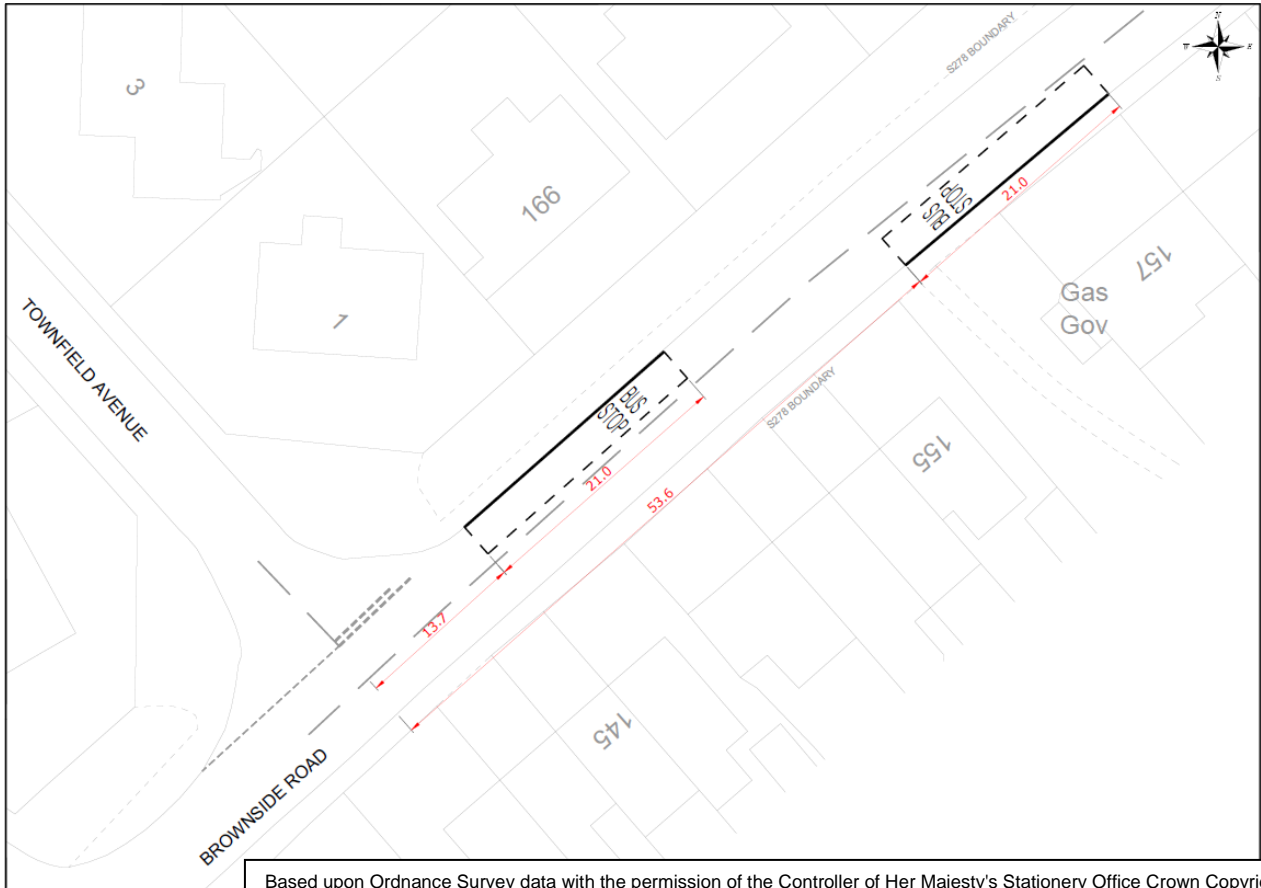


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BROWNSIDE ROAD, WORSTHORNE-WITH-HURSTWOOD,
BURNLEY BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce Bus Stop Clearways at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- 1) Brownside Road, Worsthorne-with-Hurstwood, the north west side, from a point 13.7 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Townfield Avenue for a distance of 21 metres in a north easterly direction;
- 2) Brownside Road, Worsthorne-with-Hurstwood, the south east side, from a point 53.6 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Townfield Avenue for a distance of 21 metres in a north easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops on Brownside Road, Worsthorne, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop. The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers. The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
