
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Newsham Road, Lancaster at its junction with A6 Scotforth Road, Lancaster.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Sunday 9th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Newsham Road – Wellington Road – Bowerham Road – Palatine Avenue – A6 Scotforth Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to allow open cut to reset frame and cover on A6 Scotforth Road, Lancaster under temporary two-way signals, to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
