(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Copp Lane, Great Eccleston from the property "Two Trees" to the side of house number 8 St Annes Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 7th April 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 17th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Copp Lane - Beech Road - Thistleton Road - Fleetwood Road - Garstang Road - West End - Leckonby Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to excavate 175 metres of track for LV diversion to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
