(LANCASTER AND PRESTON CITY) (REVOCATION AND AMENDMENT
TO PERMIT PARKING PROVISIONS) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 08 January 2025 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Pitt Street, Preston, Preston City) (Revocation, Amendment to Parking Provisions, Prohibition of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading) Order 2021" insofar as it relates to Schedule 2.
2. Amend the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, The Whole Of Lancashire) (Permit Parking Order Amendment (No1)) Order 2019" as set out below:
