(NATEBY CROSSING LANE, NATEBY, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Nateby Crossing Lane, Nateby from the junction with Emerald Drive to the property "Old Bridge House".
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Cockerham Road – Garstang Bypass Road – Longmoor Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Section 50 works to install 2 x road crossings & HV cable to be carried out by Aptus Utilities.
