ST GEORGES ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St Georges Road, Preston in a westerly direction from its junction with Deepdale Road to its junction with St Davids Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 17th March 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 3rd April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Deepdale Road – Sir Tom Finney Way - Blackpool Road – Garstang Road – St Georges Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out.
