(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of highway in the borough of Burnley;
  - i. Queens Park Road from its junction with Queen Victoria Road to Its merging with Ridge Avenue.
  - ii. Ridge Avenue from the roundabout with Ormerod Road to it junction with Brunshaw Road.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1600 hours on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Queen Victoria Road – Belverdere Road – Harry Potts Way – Brunshaw Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing patching works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council Highways.
