EARBY ROAD, SALTERFORTH, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Earby Road, Salterforth from its junction with Mill Cottages to its junction with Gateland.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0730 hours on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 1930 hours on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Salterforth Road – Colne Road – Kelbrook Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a new water connection to be carried out.
