Statement of Reasons

Queensway, Lytham St Annes

An upgraded access has been constructed onto Queensway, Lytham St Annes.

In order to reduce the speed of vehicles approaching the new junction, the existing 30mph speed limit requires extending eastwards.

The purpose of this proposal is to reduce the existing 40mph speed limit along Queensway, reverting the section in advance of the new access to 30mph by virtue of street lighting.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a **Section 8** Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new development which will introduce further traffic movements.

In addition, the proposal further tidies up the existing 30mph speed limits in the area by revoking the existing 30mph (restricted road) orders reverting the roads back to 30mph by virtue of street lighting. This revocation will not make any changes to the restriction or its extent on site. Therefore, drivers will not be subject to any changes as a result of this proposal.
