THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF LYTHAM ST. ANNES (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (NO.1) ORDER, 1969

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LYTHAM ST. ANNES in exercise of their powers under Section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County Palatine of Lancaster and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- This Order may be cited as the Borough Council of Lytham St. Annes (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1969.

SCHEDULE

The length of Queensway (B5261) which extends from a point 16 yards north of its junction with Mellings Lane to a point 100 yards north of its junction with Division Lane, a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1667 yards.
