(REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1998.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The Borough Council of Lytham St Annes (40mph Speed Limit) (No 1) Order, 1969, is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (B5261 Queensway, Lytham St Annes, Fylde Borough) (Revocation and Restricted Road) Order 1998 and shall come into force on the 11th May, 1998.

## SCHEDULE

B5261 Queensway, Lytham St Annes, from a point 13 metres north of the centreline of Mellings Lane to a point 90 metres north east of the centreline of Kilnhouse Lane, a distance of approximately 397 metres.
