(PEAR TREE LANE, EUXTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Pear Tree Lane, Euxton from Washington Lane, Euxton to the access into the property named The Bungalow.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Tuesday 4th February 2025 until 1730 hours on Friday 7th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Washington Lane, Euxton – West Way, Astley Village – Euxton Lane, Euxton – Pear Tree Lane, Euxton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new gas service connection works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
