RAILWAY STREET, BRIERFIELD, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Railway Street, Brierfield from its junction with Glen Way to Milton Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 2300 hours on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2025 until 0700 hours on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. No access for emergency services diversion route in place.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Colne Road – Manchester Road – Broadway – Holme Street – New Scotland Road – Scotland Road – Barrowford Road – Cuckstool Lane – Clitheroe Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow annual level crossing testing to be carried out.
