## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(DELPH LANE, OAKENCLOUGH, BLEASDALE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Delph Lane, Oakenclough from a point approximately 33 metres south of "The Row" to a point approximately 22 metres north of the entrance to "Bog House".
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Bleasdale Lane <> Hobbs Lane <> Butt Hill Lane <> Sandholme Lane <> Strickens Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
