REAR 179 TO 235 RAILWAY STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 179 to 235 Railway Street, Nelson from its junction with Berkeley Street to the rear of property number 213 Railway Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Berkeley Street – Railway Street – Selby Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement to be carried out.
