(MILL LANE, HAMBLETON & MILL LANE, OUT RAWCLIFFE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Wyre:
 - i. Mill Lane, Out Rawcliffe from outside the property "Stonehaven" to its joining with Mill Lane, Hambleton;
 - ii. Mill Lane, Hambleton from its joining with Mill Lane, Out Rawcliffe to outside the property "Rose Farm".
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Friday 28th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Whin Lane <> Turkey Street <> Cutts Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
