(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Whitehalgh Lane, Langho from a point at the railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 70 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on 10th February 2025 until 1700 hours on 14th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
4. Access for emergency services and residents will be maintained when following the diversion route.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A59 Longsight Road – Whalley Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out essential repair works to the retaining wall.
