- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 2 to 24 Norton Street, Hapton from its junction with Simpson Street to its junction with Rear 14 to 40 Simpson Street.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1530 hours on Wednesday 15th January 2025 until 2359 hours on Sunday 19th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair to leaking service in the carriageway works to be carried out.
