(GARSTANG ROAD WEST, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Garstang Road West, Poulton le Fylde outside house number 60 for approximately 15 metres in both an easterly and westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 2359 hours on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of sewer repair works to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
