## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(GREEN LANE, HALTON, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have mad an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any to proceed over that length of from Green Lane, Halton from its junction with Kirkby Lonsdale Road for a distance of approximately 200 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Wednesday 29thJanuary 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained if safe passage permits.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Green Lane – Low Road – A683 Bay Gateway – High Road – Kirkby Lonsdale Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out.
