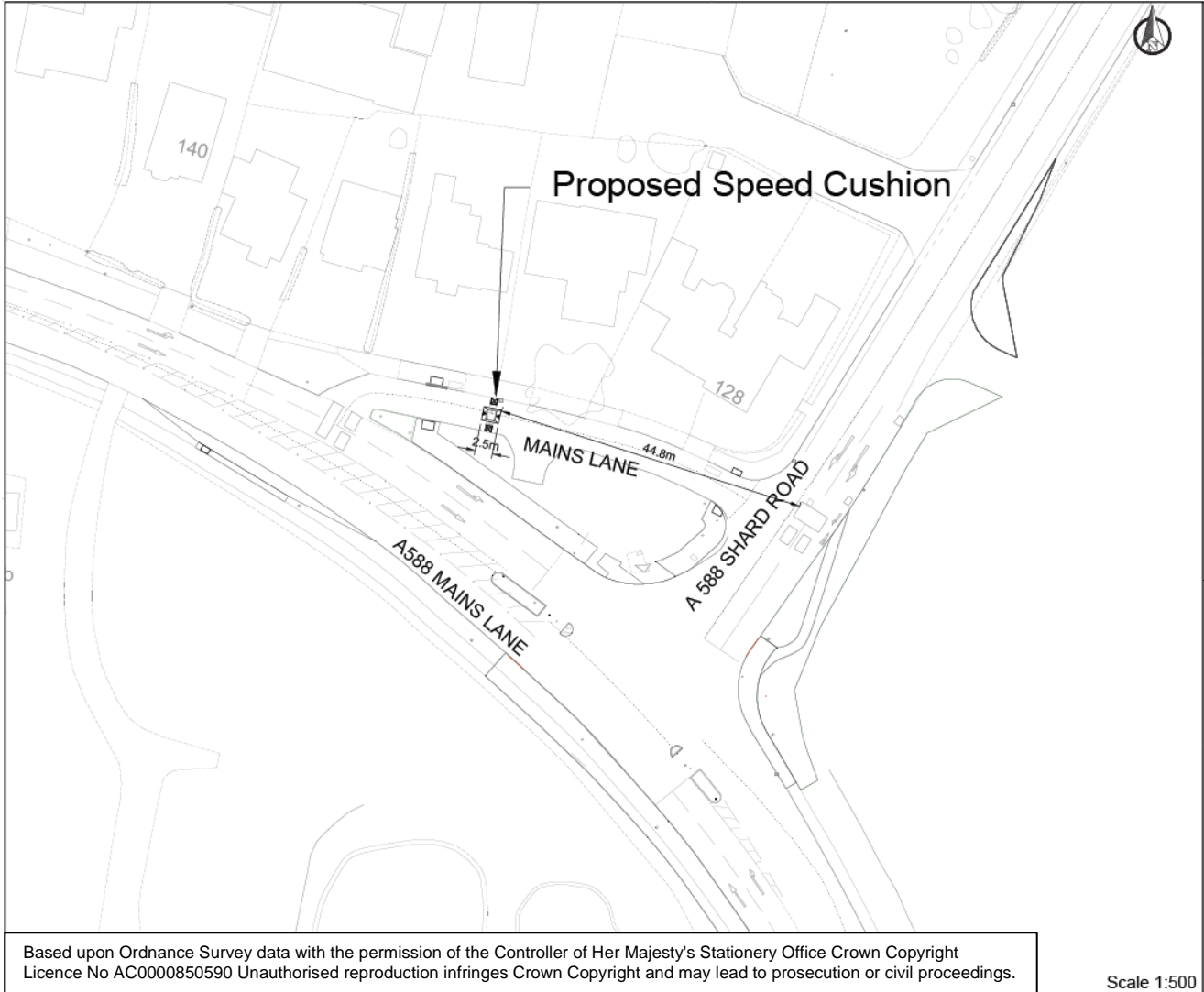


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MAINS LANE, SINGLETON, FYLDE BOROUGH) (SPEED CUSHION)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a speed cushion in Mains Lane (U47736), Singleton, from a point 44.8 metres west of its junction with the centreline of A588 Shard Road for a distance of 2.5 metres in a westerly direction.

The speed cushion will have a maximum height not exceeding 75mm.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposed speed cushion is to slow traffic down and discourage 'rat-running', allowing the safe passage of pedestrians and access to the properties due to the de-trunking works on Mains Lane.
