## THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SERVICE ROAD, LITTLE SINGLETON FYLDE BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1991

The Council of the County of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2), 3(2), 4(1) and (2) and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed along a 1 metre length of the Service Road joining Mains Lane (A585) to Shard Lane (A588) at a point 20 metres from its junction with Mains Lane (A585).
- 2) This Order shall come into operation on the 28th October, 1991 and may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Service Road Little Singleton Fylde Borough) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1991"
