BANKHOUSE ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bankhouse Road, Nelson from its junction with Hey Street to its junction with Crawford Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:
  - i. Leeds Road New Scotland Road Scotland Road Bradley Road West - Bradley Road - Bankhouse Road.
  - ii. Alternative diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the investigation of high-level fibre issues to be carried out.
