NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily restrict traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Kiln Lane and Neps Lane, Paythorne with a maximum gross vehicle weight of which exceeds 3.5 tonnes from its junction with Settle Road to a point adjacent to Bridge House.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1100 hours on 30th October 2024 until 2359 hours on 3rd November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the restriction is via: -

A682 – Hellifield Road C594 – Settle Lane U40473

The temporary prohibition is necessary to prevent further structural damage to Paythorne Bridge.
