(KILN LANE AND NEPS LANE, PAYTHORNE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Kiln Lane and Neps Lane, Paythorne with a maximum gross vehicle weight of which exceeds 3.5 tonnes from its junction with Settle Road to a point adjacent to Bridge House.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on 4th November 2024 until 2359 hours on 25th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the restriction is via: -

A682 - Hellifield Road C594 - Settle Lane U40473

The temporary prohibition is necessary to prevent further structural damage to Paythorne Bridge.
