(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Fylde:
 - i. Norfolk Road for its full extent.
 - ii. Bellingham Road for its full extent.
 - iii. Talbot Road for its full extent.
 - iv. Wykeham Road for its full extent.

2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force as follows:

Thursday 13th February 2025: 0930 hours to 1500 hours.

Friday 14th February to Monday 17th February 2025: daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours or until completion of the works within this period.

The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. **Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified.**

4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Norfolk Road: Park View Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing patching works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
