(U358 CHAPEL LANE, PARBOLD, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U358 Chapel Lane, Parbold for a distance of 20m North East and South West of Chapel Lane Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0025 hours until 0700 hours on the following dates:
 - i. Sunday 23rd February 2025
 - Sunday 2nd March 2025

or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.

- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U358 Chapel Lane, Parbold is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow technical inspection and rail corrosion assessment works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management in conjunction with Network Rail.
