(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Extwistle Road, Burnley from Extwistle Road from its junction with Water Street to its junction with Showfield.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Friday 28th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Extwistle Road – Todmorden Road - Briercliffe Road - A6114 – Brunshaw Road-Red Lees Road – Saltford Lane - Ormerod Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new cable connection works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd on behalf of BT Openreach.
