NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce:

- 1) Remove a raised zebra crossing and associated road markings in Railway Street, Nelson, from a point 16.1 metres south east of its junction with Broadway for a distance of 25.7 metres in a south easterly direction.
- 2) Introduce a priority crossing in Railway Street, Nelson, from its junction with Broadway for a distance of 14.8 metres in a south easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of these proposals are to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.
