
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Borwick Lane, Warton from its junction with Main Street to its junction with Chapel Walk.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access for emergency services will be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Borwick Lane – Hyning Lane – Rose Acre Lane – A6 Milnthorpe Road – A6 Scotland Road – Borwick Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to ensure safety while engineers access underground structure to carry out cabling works on behalf of Openreach.
