(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mersey Street, Longridge from its junction with Berry Lane to a point outside number 4 Mersey Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 7th April 2025 until 1800 hours on 8th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Berry Lane – King Street – Higher Road – Green Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to install a fire hydrant.
