(MERSEY STREET, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mersey Street, Longridge from its junction with Berry Lane to a point outside number 4 Mersey Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 7th April 2025 until 1800 hours on 8th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Berry Lane - King Street - Higher Road - Green Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to install a fire hydrant.
