(ESHTON TERRACE, CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Eshton Terrace, Clitheroe from a point at the level crossing travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative overnight from 2300 hours on 18th April 2025 until 0700 hours on 19th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
- **Easterly** Woone Lane Moor Lane Parsons Lane Badlands Thorn Street
- Westerly Thorn Street Badlands Station Road King Street Market Place – Wellgate – Lowergate – Whalley Road – Greenacre Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry out an inspection of the level crossing.
