TITHEBARN STREET AND OLD VICARAGE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Tithebarn Street and Old Vicarage from its junction with North Road to its junction with Lancaster Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2000 hours until 0600 hours from Monday 17th February 2025 until Tuesday 1st April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Old Vicarage Diversion:


Carlise Street – Ring Way – Lancaster Road.

Lancaster Road Diversion:

Carlisle Street – Pole Street – Lords Walk – Church Row – Church Street – Fishergate – Market Place – Earl Street – Lancaster Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow weather permitting surfacing and s278 works for Preston Animate to be carried out.
