TITHEBARN STREET AND OLD VICARAGE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Tithebarn Street and Old Vicarage from its junction with North Road to its junction with Lancaster Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2000 hours until 0600 hours from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

## Old Vicarage Diversion:

Carlise Street - Ring Way - Lancaster Road.

## Lancaster Road Diversion:

Carlisle Street – Pole Street – Lords Walk – Church Row – Church Street – Fishergate – Market Place – Earl Street – Lancaster Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow weather permitting surfacing and s278 works for Preston Animate to be carried out.
