(C117 SMITHY LANE, AUGHTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C117 Smithy Lane, Aughton from the western boundary of property number 82 to a point 30m West of property number 37.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 17th February 2025 until 1700 hours on Saturday 22nd February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will not be maintained due to the nature of the works making the passage of vehicles not feasibly possible.
- 4. Pedestrian and cycle access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U992 St Michael Road, Aughton – C118 Church Lane, Aughton – C117 Bold Lane, Aughton and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow electrical cable jointing works to be carried out by Site Safe Traffic Solutions in conjunction with Scottish Power.
