

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(WHINS LANE, SIMONSTONE, RIBBLE VALLEY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Whins Lane, Simonstone from its junction with Trapp Lane to its junction with Barrowford Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025 hours or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Barrowford Road – Whalley Road – School Lane – Trapp Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out carriageway surface dressing patching works.
