
HOLLINGTON STREET AND GABLE END 178 COTTON TREE LANE, COLNE,
PENDLE BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hollington Street and Gable End 187 Cotton Tree Lane, Colne.
-Hollington Street, Colne from its junction with Cotton Tree Lane to its junction with Rear 105 Cotton Tree Lane to South West Facing Wall Standroyd Mill
-Gable End 187 Cotton Tree Lane, Colne from its junction with Cotton Tree Lane to its junction with Rear 105 Cotton Tree Lane to South West Facing Wall Standroyd Mill
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 3rd March 2025 until 1700 hours on Monday 17th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Cotton Tree Lane – Lambeth Street - Rear 105 Cotton Tree Lane to South West Facing Wall Standroyd Mill and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out.
